In this short film, teenagers from one all-male school in West Philadelphia share their stories of losing friends to neighborhood gun violence. They detail the rupture that occurs when they learn about a shooting and the many ways they memorialize their friends. The young men speak candidly and honestly about the way friends' deaths have affected their ideas about their futures and the future of their city.
